RE: Estate Recovery Changes

DATE: December 21, 2021

This memorandum provides information on changes to the Estate Recovery Program under Title 49 O.C.G.A. § 49-4-147.1, and the Rules of Georgia Department of Community Health, Chapter 111-3-8 Rules and Regulations for Estate Recovery the following changes are effective as of July 1, 2018:

- The State will waive estate recovery of the first \$25,000 of estates valued over \$25,000 for any estate subject to an Estate Recovery claim for the deceased Medicaid Member with a date of death on or after July 1, 2018.
- Each member and/or authorized representative must receive notification of Estate Recovery at application and each renewal via first class mail or electronic means.
